Executive Summary (PPN 06/21)

Crest Medical Ltd is committed to reducing greenhouse gas emissions and supporting the UK Government's Net Zero strategy. This Carbon Reduction Plan (CRP) has been prepared in accordance with Procurement Policy Note (PPN) 06/21 and the associated Carbon Reduction Plan Technical Standard.

Crest Medical measures and reports Scope 1 and Scope 2 emissions in full, and selected Scope 3 emissions in line with the Greenhouse Gas (GHG) Protocol and data availability. Emissions data is independently reviewed by Planet Mark as part of its certification process.

Crest Medical has set a long-term Net Zero ambition aligned to a 90% absolute reduction in Scope 1 and Scope 2 emissions, with residual emissions addressed through offsetting in the target year. Scope 3 reduction efforts currently focus on measured categories, with plans to expand coverage and ambition as data quality and supplier engagement improve.

This plan is reviewed annually and will be updated as best practice, regulatory guidance, and organisational maturity evolution.

Commitment to achieving Net Zero

Crest Medical Ltd is committed to reducing its greenhouse gas emissions and supporting the UK's transition to a low-carbon economy. Our long-term ambition is to achieve Net Zero emissions across Scope 1 and Scope 2, and to significantly reduce Scope 3 emissions over time as data quality and supply-chain engagement continue to improve.

Our approach is aligned with the Greenhouse Gas (GHG) Protocol and is supported through independent third-party measurement and verification by Planet Mark.



Baseline emissions are a record of the greenhouse gases that have been produced in the past and were produced prior to the introduction of any strategies to reduce emissions. Baseline emissions are the reference point against which emissions reduction can be measured.

Baseline Year: 2022**Additional Details relating to the Baseline Emissions calculations:**

Our Baseline year is 2022 for scopes 1&2. Scope 3 had not been measured for 2022.

Crest Medical Ltd transitioned to Planet Mark in April 2023 to measure Scopes 1, 2 and extended Scope 3 annually, aligned to the Greenhouse Gas Protocol.


Emissions targets:

To continue our progress to achieving Net Zero, we have adopted the following carbon reduction plan. This carbon reduction plan is approved by our board and shared with all relevant stakeholders.

Crest Medical Ltd has adopted the following targets:

- 50% reduction in Scope 3 emissions by 2030
- Net Zero Scope 1 & 2 by 2032
- Carbon Neutrality on Scopes 1, 2 & 3 by 2030
- Net Zero across all scopes by 2045

Progress against these targets can be seen in the graphs below:



Key achievements in this reporting year include:

1. -6.8% comparison of Scope 1&2 emissions versus the previous year.
2. -5.2% comparison of absolute measured emissions vs 2024 (normalised)
3. 355.9 tCO₂e measured carbon footprint (market-based)
4. 3.1 tCO₂e measured carbon footprint per full time employee (market-based)

This has been achieved through the adoption of a clear strategic plan driven by Senior Management and through the sustainability committee to drive our carbon footprint down, and can be highlighted through the various projects this year:



Carbon Reduction Projects

Completed initiatives include relocation to a sustainable headquarters, increased renewable energy usage, warehouse efficiency improvements, low-emission transport policies, and development of sustainable product ranges.

Future initiatives include product lifecycle analysis, supplier engagement on emissions, transition to 100% renewable electricity, fleet electrification, and expanded Scope 3 data quality.

Our progress reduction plan across all three scopes is still on track with the objective of achieving net zero (90%) by 2045.

Our next steps towards reducing our carbon emissions on Scope 3 will include the following to improve data quality to increase the % of supplier activity. We are in the early stages of planning our net zero transition plan and we will continue to update our progress.

An outlined plan will focus on the following:

- Category 1:
 - Collecting further activity for all suppliers.
 - Collaborating with suppliers for LCA/EPD data where it is available.
- Category 7:
 - Endeavour to get to a 100% response rate on our staff commuting survey.
- Category 12:
 - Conduct a customer survey to track our sold goods at the end of their life.

We will be keeping an eye on future developments and best practices, and, where necessary, we will increase the breadth of our initiatives and validation routes. This includes ISO 14001 – the principles of which remain a guiding factor in our journey.
